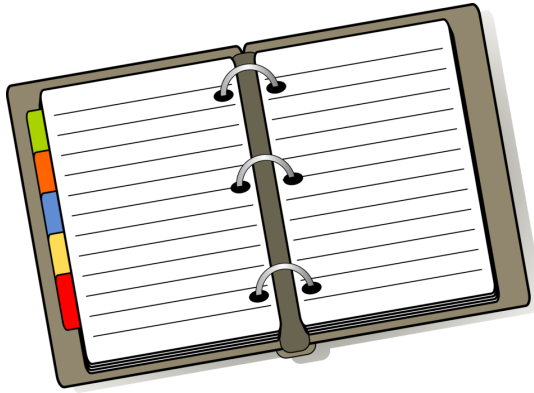

Spalding

Scholars will learn 30 Spalding words a week. On Thursday, scholars will review the week's words and Friday they will be tested. Additionally, scholars will receive a regular Oral Phonogram Review and a Written Phonogram Review. Homework Policy



Homework Time Spent:

Homework allows scholars to practice what they learned during the day. Each morning in class, scholars are expected to fill out their agenda for homework. The Family Handbook explains that scholars in 4th grade can expect an average of 20 minutes for reading and 40-50 minutes each night devoted to homework.

Late Policy:

To encourage scholars to complete their homework, late homework will be accepted within two days of the due date for 50%. If scholars turn in a late assignment three days after the due date, it will not be accepted.

Absence Policy:

When scholars are absent, they are responsible for making up their work. If an absence is due to an illness, please contact the teacher for homework, not the office. When possible, please coordinate with friends or other family members to pick up missed assignments. If an absence is excused due to an illness, doctor appointment, bereavement, family emergency or out-of-school detention, the scholar will have the same number of days to turn their missed work in as they missed. For example, if the scholar missed 2 days due to an illness, he/she will have 2 days to make up the missed work.

In the case of an unexcused absence teachers will not be able to prepare anticipated missing work ahead of the absence. At the discretion of the Headmaster, students may not be allowed to make-up missed work due to an unexcused absence.

Bathroom Policy

To ensure scholars do not miss instructional time, we encourage scholars to use the bathroom during lunch and/or recess. Every Monday scholars are provided with two bathroom pass tickets. Scholars are responsible for their tickets, which are kept in their pencil pouch or desk. When scholars need to go to the restroom

during instructional time, they will use one of their tickets to go to the restroom. If a scholar does not use their tickets, they are not allowed to 'roll-over' tickets into the following week. If your scholar has health concerns that interfere with this bathroom policy, please contact the teacher.

Birthday Policy



Your Classroom Parent and teachers will coordinate the particular recess date for each birthday month celebration. This will typically be the last week of the month. If your child has a birthday in that particular month, you will be able to organize healthy refreshments to celebrate your child's special day. However, please abide by the no sweets policy. You can refer to the Birthday Treats document for treat ideas.

Having a birthday party for your child?

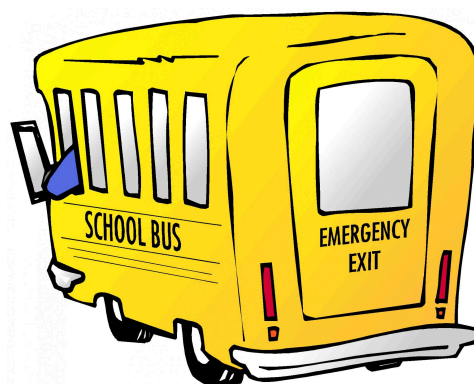
If everyone from the class will be invited (or ALL girls/ALL boys), your child may provide invitations to his/her teachers to be put in backpacks at the end of the day. If there is not an invitation for every scholar (or every scholar of one gender), the teachers will give the invites back to your child to take home. If only certain scholars from a class will be invited, the invites must be delivered by an adult off school grounds, or mailed by the parent. It is up to the child to get contact information for those he/she would like to invite or you may utilize the Fourleaf Family Directory. Scholars may NOT pass out invites at school.
