Special considerations plural ending -s




Red Hen had ten eggs.

The bag of eggs was for Nan.


Red Hen and Rod Rat • Consonant Rr

"I will get the eggs," he said.






Rod Rat had the bag.

“Do not rip my bag of eggs.”


Red Hen and Rod Rat • Consonant Rr
