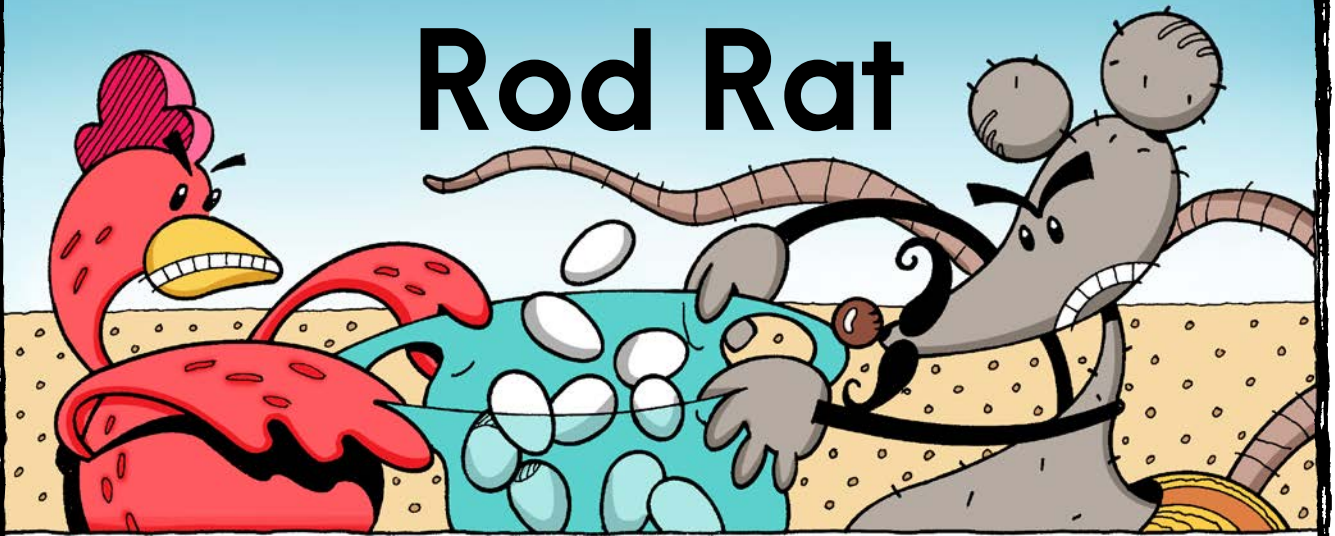

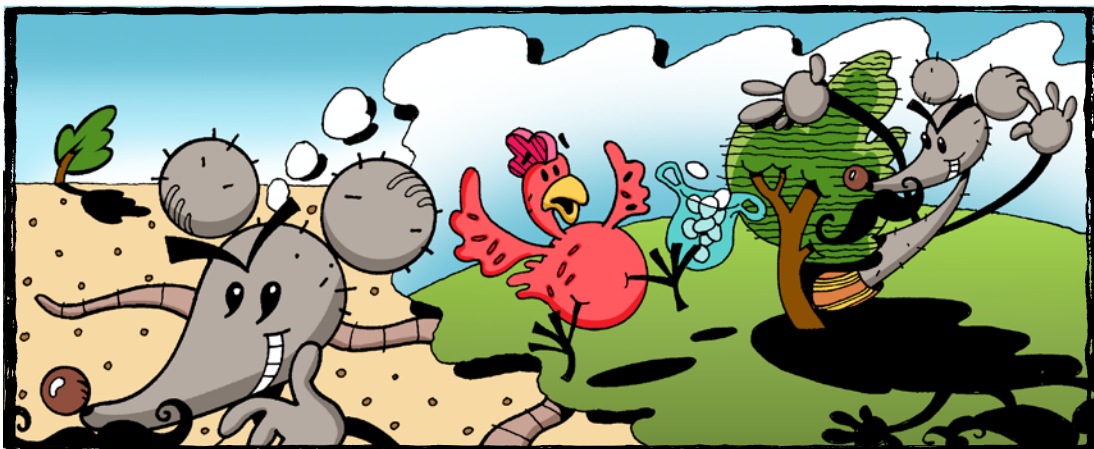

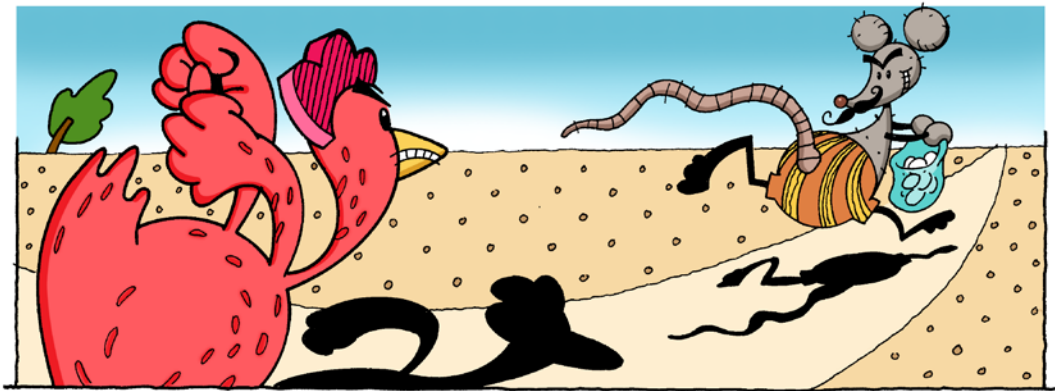

Words with new phonic element **ram, ran, rat, red, rip, rob, rod**

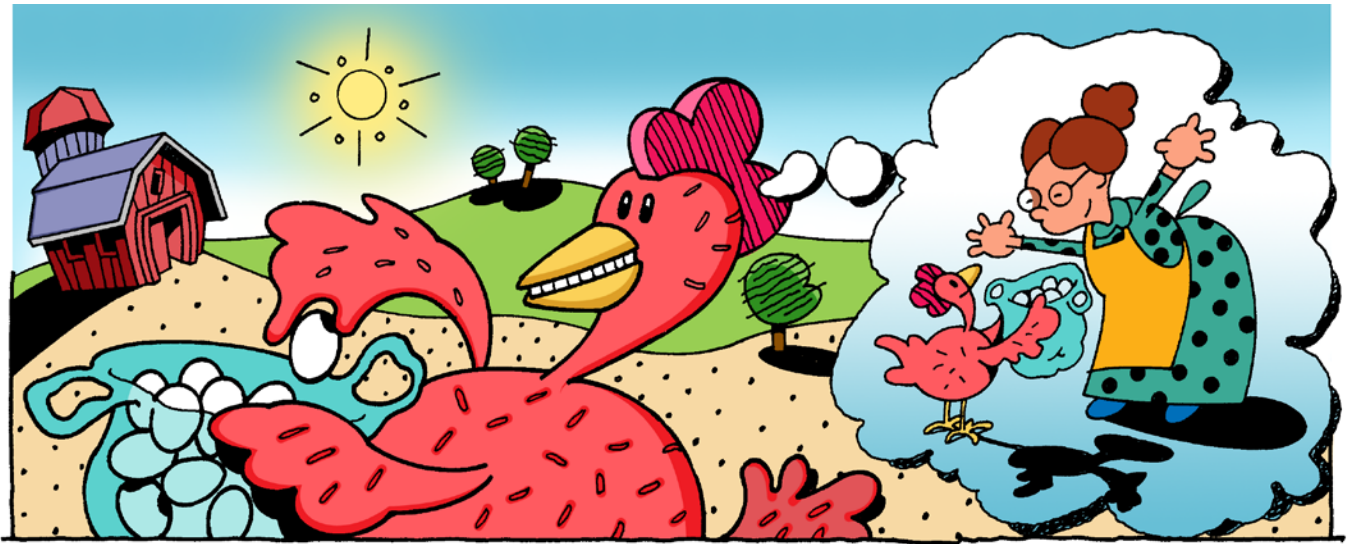
Reviewed phonic elements **n, a, m, t, o, d, e, h, g, i, b**

Special considerations plural ending **-s**



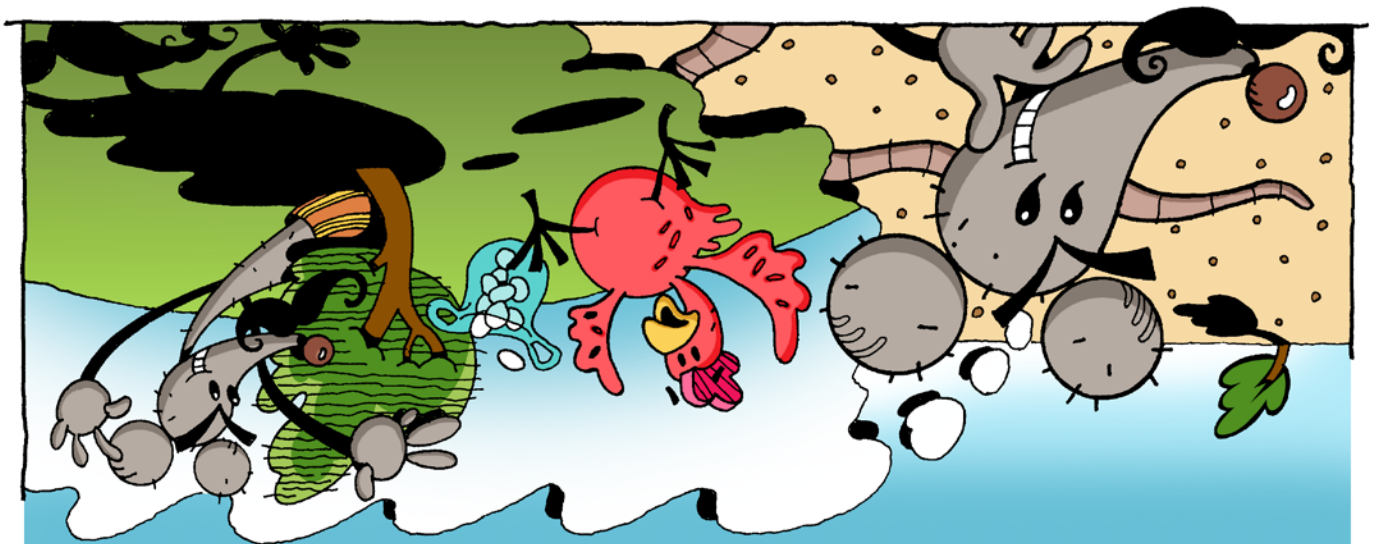
Red Hen had ten eggs.

The bag of eggs was for Nan.

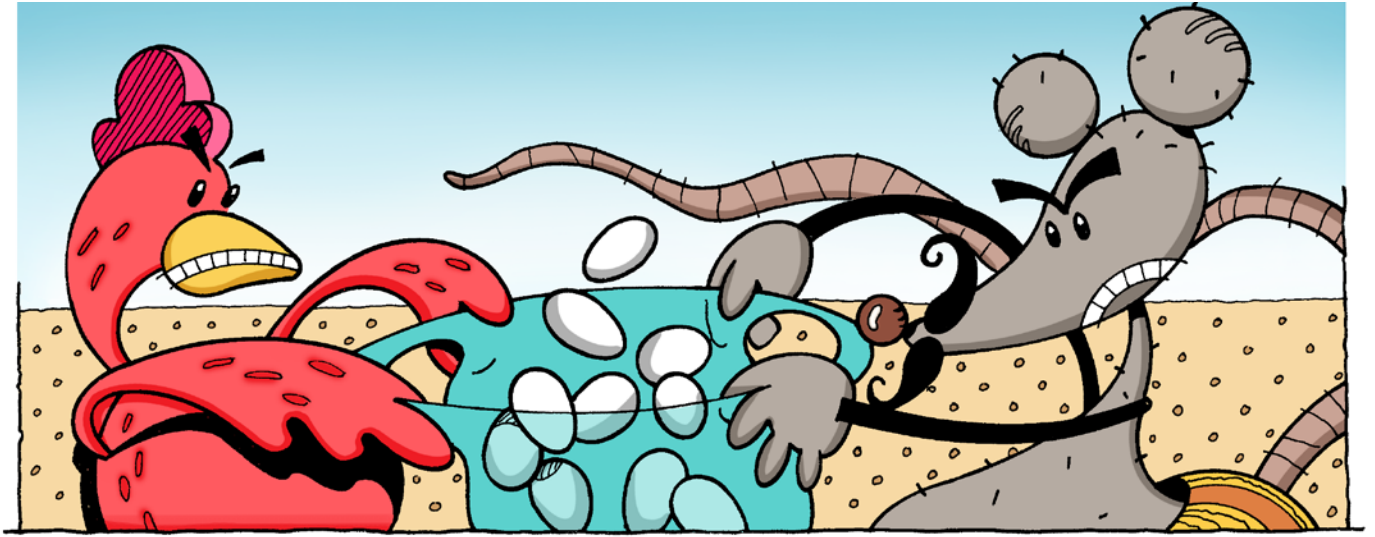
Red Hen and Rod Rat • Consonant Rr

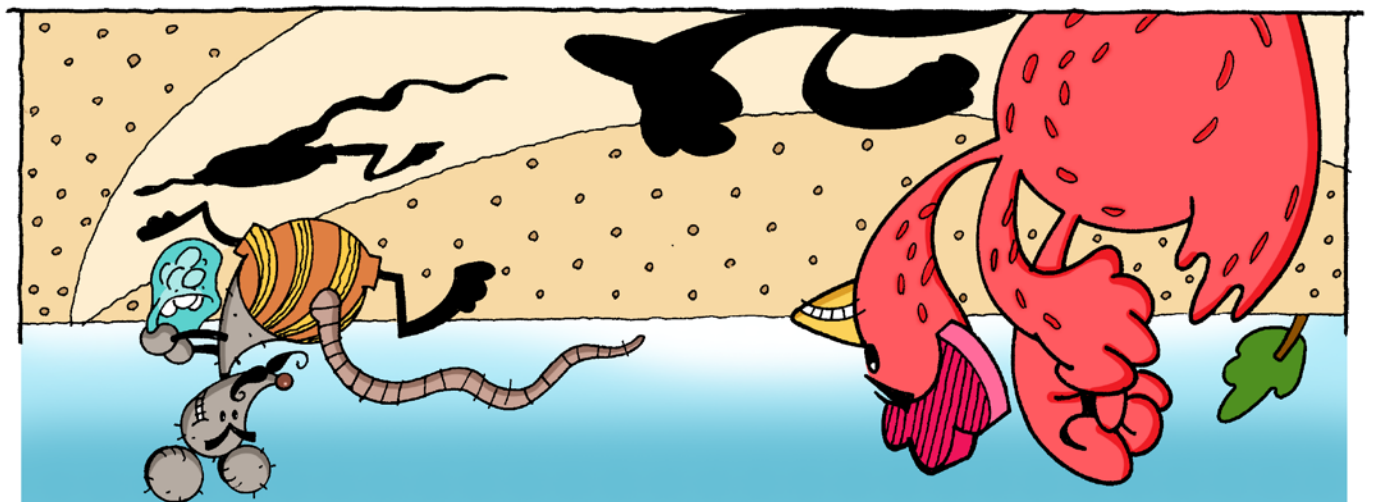
Rod Rat had the bag.

“Do not rip my bag of eggs.”

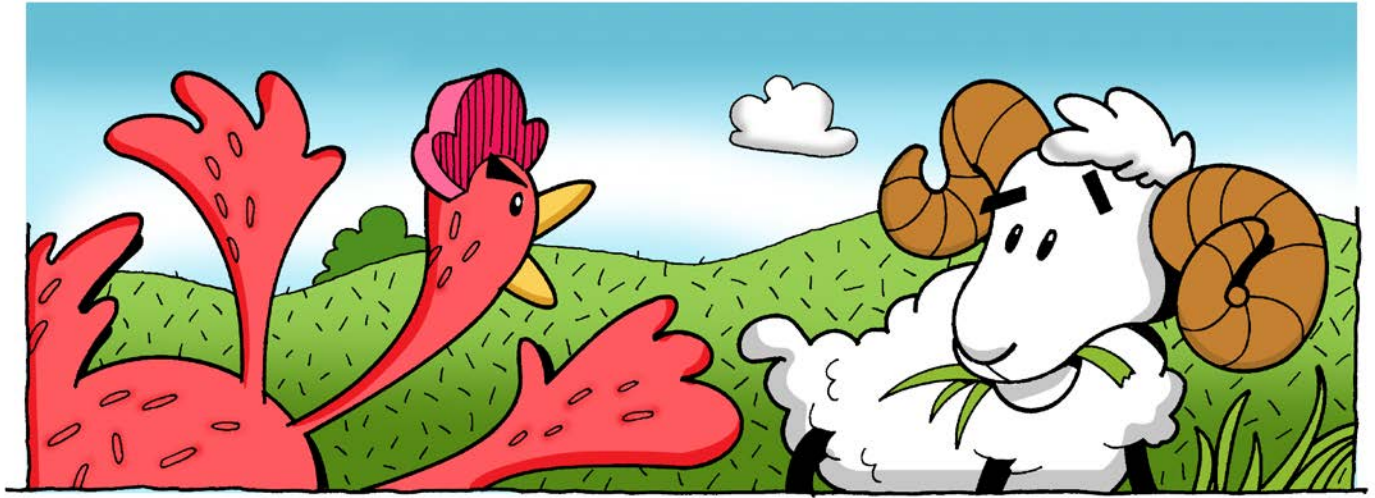
