#### **Recent Updates**

- Governor's order to delay in-person start to until August 17th.
- Archway Trivium West will begin mandatory distance learning August 6th and resume in-person learning on August 31st. Should local officials extend school closures, we will certainly comply and notify you of any changes.
- Trivium Preparatory Academy will begin on the same dates as the Archway.
- Our Meet the Teacher event will be held online this year on the same date as previously scheduled, August 3rd. Details to come.
- The mask policy was shared with all families and students by the president of Great Hearts Arizona, Erik Twist.

### What is happening right now?

- Reviewing and refining plans for Distance Learning with the input of our teachers
- Regular meetings with all headmasters in Arizona to share best practices and receive guidance from the home office
- New faculty is conducting training virtually and is being coordinated by the home office
- All returning faculty started training last week and will continue training this week.

#### How do we re-open (when the time is right)?



#### 1. Prevention

- Face coverings- required for students over 2 years of age. May be removed while sitting at their desk.
- Plexiglass shields on each desk
- Temperature checks for all students, teachers and visitors upon arrival
- Enhance cleaning routines
- Hand sanitizer stations
- Education and training for teachers and students
- Hospital grade air filters in our buildings
- Circulating more outside air

## 2. Social Distancing

- Students will remain in with their section "cohort" all day except for recess
- Students will dismiss from the classroom to the carline rather than gathering in the MPR
- Desks will be spaced apart to the extent we are able
- Students will eat in the MPR but we will not exceed 50% occupancy, and students will sit with students from their own section
- Students will be permitted to play and interact with their peers at recess

#### 3. Incident Response

COVID response team:

- 1. COVID Response Coordinator- Ms. Uphoff (Safety Coordinator)
- 2. Response Team- HM, AHM, Facilities technician, nurse, reporting party
- 3. Nurse will work with local authorities to confirm cases and follow guidelines based on community spread. Nurse will also quarantine any students who have COVID symptoms and contact families.
- 4. HM will work with GH on response to any cases or changes in community spread

## 5. Remote Learning/ 6. Contingency Plans

#### <u>GHDL</u> (Great Hearts Distance Learning)

- Students may opt in to DL at any time, but can only return to campus at the start of a quarter
- All students and staff will be enrolled in Google Classroom to start the year so that we are prepared for shut down
- Daily live teaching from classroom teachers.
- Regular structure to the school day that requires participation from students at particular times of day. Schedules will be shared by teachers on or before MTTN.
- Real grades will be given for student work
- No paper packets

#### Building Community... *differently*

- Community events will be held online for at least the first quarter
- Classrooms will participate in community building activities at the class and grade level.
- Our PSO will still serve the community under the leadership of our board. PSO board meetings will have virtual options during the school year.
