For grades 1-5, the PSO will reward the scholar who reads the most minutes in their grade level with a book of their choice from the book fair! Additionally, the top 3 readers in each grade will be featured in the school yearbook. All minutes spent reading during the 10 days can be added to the reading log. The minutes will add up quickly! \*Kindergartners are allowed to participate as well, but since reading is often done by or with a parent, they are not competing grade wide.

Additionally, the classroom with the most participants will be rewarded with a popcorn party by the PSO! Encourage your classmates to participate!

The Read-a-Thon will be held October 4-13. The annual Paper Pie Book Fair will be November 5-8 in the school library. Details to follow at a later date.

The reading log will be sent home with the scholars the week of September 30 and will also be available on the school website. New this year, we are not collecting any pledges during the Read-a-Thon. All scholars are able to compete for the book reward and recognition in the yearbook, as well as the classroom popcorn party.
