"This Land is Your Land" was written in 1940 by Woody Guthrie, a folk singer, song writer, social commentator, and folk hero. When Woody Guthrie first got the idea for this song, "God Bless America" was getting a lot of air play on the radio. Woody originally wrote the last line as "God blessed this land for me" instead of "this land was made for you and me." By the mid-1950s school song books were including the chorus and three verses which are now widely known and used in this choral arrangement.
