

Archway Trivium Summer Reading Challenge

Who: Kindergarten – Fourth Grade Archway Trivium Scholars

What: Read at least 20 minutes per day. You can read more, but not less! Parents can read to their child and scholars can read to a parent, write it down on the attached reading log. Please choose appropriate books, not too easy or too hard! Try the 5-finger rule: have your child read a page from the book and count the number of errors. If your child has 5 errors before the end of the page, then the book is too difficult. If you need another log, just make copies, or use regular paper. Keep track of your minutes on the log and have your parents sign it.

When: May 25 - August 3, 2025

Bring your reading logs to school on Meet the Teacher or the first day school! We will collect these from the teachers. We will have a reading celebration with popsicles and an extra recess near the end of the first quarter of 2025-26 school year.

Where: Books can be read just about anywhere!

We certainly understand about vacations and if there is a time that your child will not be able to read, please write on the dates you were not able to read. We take books, audiobooks, or a tablet when we go on vacations, so we always have something to read.
